

# Pass/Fail in Brightspace

**Pass/Fail Final Grade in a Course** (Scheme = Pass/Fail checked in Setup Wizard when beginning Manage Grades) – *ACD is approved as a Pass/Fail course*

- 1. Pass/Fail Grade Item** (NOT linked to a quiz, discussion or assignment)
- 2. Pass/Fail Assignment** (NOT linked to a grade item, only as assignment)
- 3. Pass/Fail Assignment** (assignment linked to a selectbox grade item)

*NOTE 1: You cannot link a quiz or a discussion to a pass/fail selectbox item for pass fail.*

*NOTE 2: Assignments can only be associated with a numeric or selectbox grade item type.*

P/F Grade Item LINKED with an Assignment OR Assignment LINKED with a Grade Item</b>	YES	<b>Selectbox</b>	<b>+ Pass/Fail Scheme</b> <b>+ Student View + Managing View:</b> Override display options – Select only Grade Scheme Symbol (to Show Pass or Fail in Grades)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assignment is required for grades but doesn't need detailed marks – just Pass or Fail</li> <li>• Assignment could be worth 0% of final grade or any percentage or marks but in end P/F</li> <li>• Want to focus on simplified grading and more so on feedback as a process</li> </ul>
